Georges Gojat was born May 18, 1922, in Lyons, France. He received his degree from the Institute of Political Studies in Paris, and attended the French National School of Administration.

In 1954-1955 he served in the French Audit Office (La Cour des Comptes).

In 1955 he became technical adviser to the French Minister of Labor and served as technical advisor to the French delegation at the first European regional conference of the International Labor Organization (I.L.O.)

From 1955 to 1957 he was a member of the staff preparing the treaties of the European Economic and European Atomic Energy Communities. In 1958, he became chief executive assistant to Louis Armand, President of European Atomic Energy Community Commission. In 1960 he became Director of the Budget and Financial Controller of the Euratom Commission.

Currently he is Deputy Financial Controller in the new European Communities Commission.

He has also taught at the Law School of the University of Paris, the Institute of Political Studies in Paris, and the School of Social Services.
