Representative Wright Patman (D., Texas), Chairman of the Joint Economic Committee, today announced the appointment to the Committee staff of Dr. John B. Henderson as economist, specializing in international affairs.

Dr. Henderson received his M.A. from the University of St. Andrews, Scotland, was a graduate student in economics at King's College, Cambridge, England, and received his Ph.D. at Harvard University in 1956. He was with the Federal Reserve Bank of New York for 4 years, first in the Foreign Research Division and later in the Balance of Payments Division. Before coming to the Joint Economic Committee, he was Andrew Wells Robertson Professor of Economics, and Chairman of the Department of Economics at Allegheny College.

This position on the Committee staff has been vacant since Dr. Gerald A. Pollack resigned to accept appointment as Deputy Assistant Secretary of Commerce for Economic Affairs.
