MR. STANLEY PATRICK JOHNSON

Mr. Stanley Patrick Johnson is presently Adviser in the Environment and Consumer Protection Service within the Commission of the European Communities, Brussels, Belgium.

He was born on August 18, 1940 in England and is married with four children. He was educated at Sherborne College and Exeter College, Oxford. He was a Trevelyan Scholar, Senior Classics Scholar and Harkness Fellow (US). He obtained his M.A. at Oxford in 1963.

He has worked with the World Bank (1966-1968), as Project Director with the UNA-USA National Policy Panel on World Population 1968-1969, as a member of the Conservative Research Department in Great Britain 1969-1970, on the staff of the International Planned Parenthood Federation in London 1971-1973, as a consultant to the UN Fund for Population activities 1971-1973, and as a member of the Countryside Commission 1971-1973.

Mr. Johnson is a writer in his free time and won the Newdigate Prize for Poetry in 1962. He has published four non-fiction books concerned with population problems and the environment and three novels with a fourth to be published shortly. Mr. Johnson is also interested in travel.
