Association of European University Teachers  
Meets in Luxembourg

The Association of European University Teachers today opened a three-day meeting in Luxembourg. Aim of the conference, which is taking place at the headquarters of the High Authority of the European Coal and Steel Community, is to study economic and juridical aspects of the common market and of common European institutions. Reports to be drawn up by the conference will be presented at a plenary meeting of the Association in September, 1957.

The conference is being attended by 25 university teachers from eight West European countries, including Britain, Sweden and Austria, as well as all the Community countries except Luxembourg.

A draft statement on the principles of the common market was today presented by M. André Philip, former French Minister of Finance and Economics, and a notable supporter of the European idea.

The conference will end on October 1.
