#### EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

on the extension of certain provisions governing the first stage of the Agreements establishing an association between the European Economic Community on the one hand and Malta and Cyprus on the other.

1. The provisions governing the first stage of the Agreements with Malta and Cyprus and the provisions of the Protocols concluded with those two countries expire on 30 June.

2. Negotiations are in progress with Malta and Cyprus for the conclusion of additional protocols to the Association Agreements extending the first stage of those Agreements beyond 1 July. There is no chance, however, of the two protocols entering into force on that date.

3. In the circumstances and in order to avoid a legal vacuum in the Community's relations with Malta and Cyprus, the Commission proposes that the Council adopt the draft regulations autonomously extending certain provisions governing the first stage of the Agreements with Malta and Cyprus until the entry into force of the additional protocols now being negotiated or until 31 December, whichever is the sooner.

4. The question of "Cyprus Sherry" type wine will be the subject of a separate Communication by the Commission to the Council.

Mnereas, pending the conclusion of that protocol, the arrangements which the Community applies to trade with Malta under the association with that country should be extended,

## HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

#### Article 1

The trade arrangements provided for in the Agreement establishing an association between the European Economic Community and Malta, including the Protocol laying down certain provisions relating to that Agreement consequent on the accession of new Hember States to the Community but excluding the provisions of Articles 4, 9(1) and 11 of the said Protocol, and in Decision no 1/76 of the Association Council of 29 June 1976 derogating from the concept of "originating products" for reception apparatus falling within heading No 85.15 of the Brussels Tariff Nomenclature<sup>1</sup>, shall remain coplicable in the Community beyond 30 June 1977 and until the entry into force of the additional protocol or until 31 December 1977, whichever is the sconer.

## Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 July 1977.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

## Article 1

The trade arrangements provided for in the Agreement establishing an association between the European Economic Community and the Republic of Cyprus, including the Protocol laying down certain provisions relating to that Agreement consequent on the accession of new Member States to the Community but excluding the provisions of Articles 4, 10(1), 13 and 15 of the said Protocol, shall remain applicable in the Community beyond 30 June 1977 and until the entry into force of the additional protocol or until 31 December 1977, whichever is the sooner.

## <u>Article 2</u>

For the products covered by Article 59(1) (b) of the Act

of Accession<sup>1</sup>, the provisions

of Article 4 of the Protocol laying down certain provisions relating to the Agreement establishing an association between the European Economic Community and the Republic of Cyprus shall remain applicable until 31 December 1977.

## Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 July 1977.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
