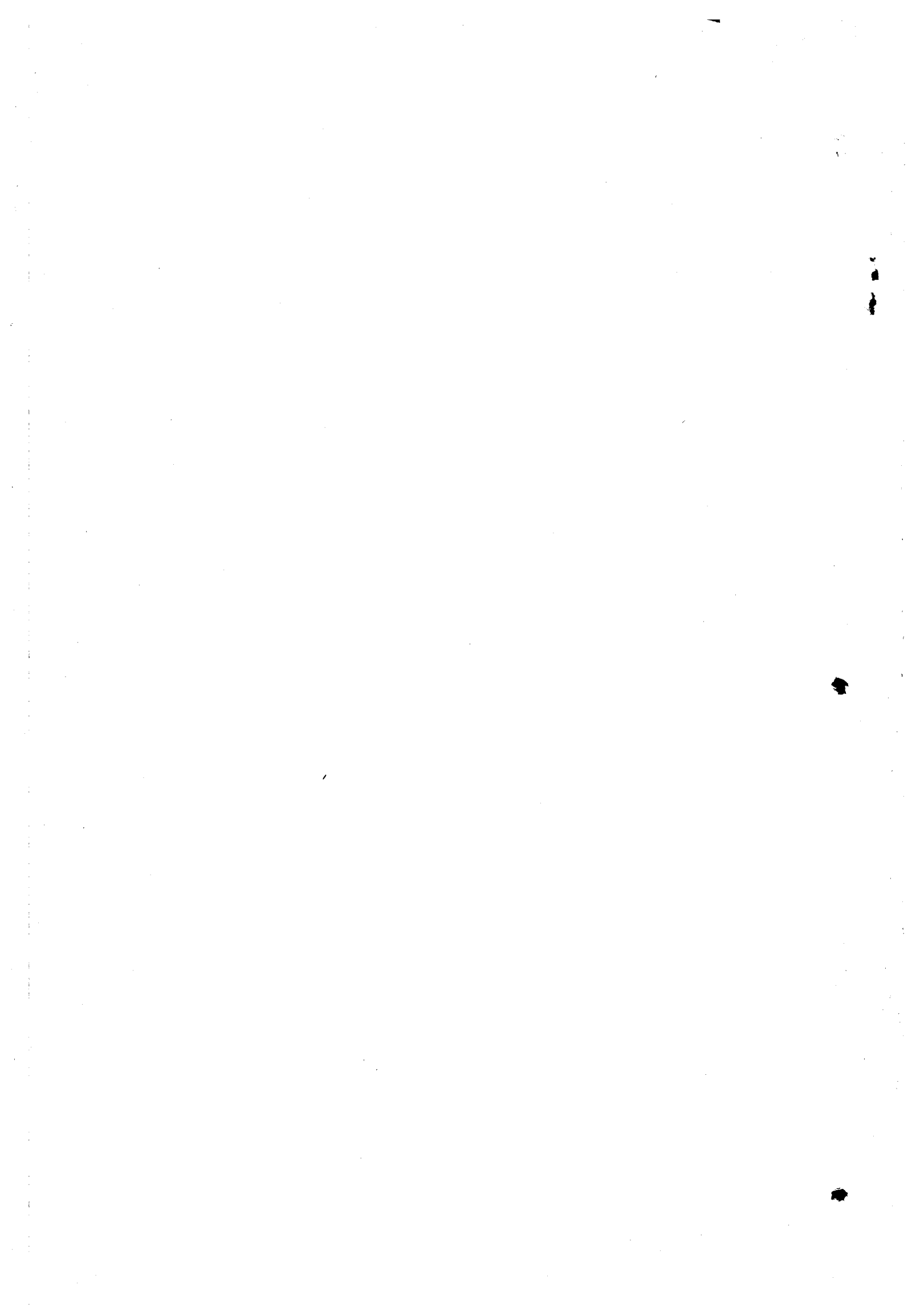

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The Trade Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Argentine Republic concluded on 8 November 1971 for a period of three years entered into force on 1 January 1972 and expires on 31 December 1979 after four extensions for a period of one year as provided for in article 9 (2) of the Agreement.

The Argentine Mission to the European Communities has made known verbally to the Commission's services that the Argentine Government considers it advisable to renew the agreement again.

Considering that the Trade Agreement of 8 November 1971 should again be extended for one year,

The Commission recommends that the Council :

- adopts the draft Decision annexed hereto concluding an agreement, in the form of an exchange of letters, extending the Trade Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Argentine Republic for a period of one year.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 113 thereof,

Having regard to the Recommendation from the Commission,

Whereas the Trade Agreement between the European Economic Community and the Argentine Republic<sup>1</sup> should be extended for one year as provided for in Article 9 (2) thereof,

HAS DECIDED AS FOLLOWS:

Article 1

The Agreement in the form of an exchange of letters between the European Economic Community and the Argentine Republic extending the Trade Agreement signed in Brussels on 8 November 1971 is hereby concluded on behalf of the European Economic Community. The text of the exchange of letters is annexed to this Decision.

Article 2

The President of the Council is hereby authorized to designate the persons empowered to sign the Agreement and to confer on them the powers required in order to bind the Community.
