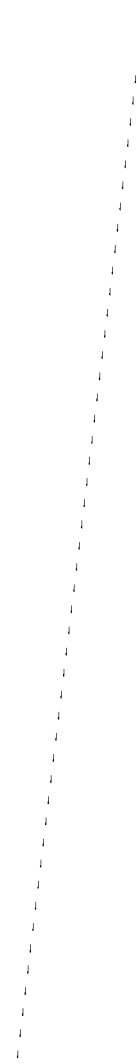

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The purpose of this Regulation is to extend the trade arrangements with Malta autonomously until 31 December 1982 pending the opening of negotiations to give trade arrangements with that country a contractual form.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN
COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European
Economic Community, and in particular Article 113
thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas, Regulation (EEC) No 3508/80⁽¹⁾, as
amended by Regulation (EEC) No 3670/81⁽²⁾, has
extended the arrangements applicable to trade with
Malta until 30 June 1982 ;

Whereas the conditions justifying this extension still
exist ; whereas the period of validity of the said Regula-
tion should therefore be extended,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

In Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 3508/80, 30
June 1982 is hereby replaced by 31 December 1982 .

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day of its
publication in the *Official Journal of the European
Communities*.

It shall apply with effect from 1 July 1982

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member
States.
