COM(82) 741 final

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. By Regulation (EEC) No 2915/82 of 28 October 1982 (1), the Commission authorised Denmark to suspend the issue of export licences for aluminium waste and scrap under sub-heading 76.01 B of the Common Customs Tariff. This regime for Denmark replaced that of simple export surveillance implemented by the Community and, for 1982, by Council Regulation (EEC) No 3568/81 (2). The need to authorise Denmark to suspend the issue of export licences arose because of the threat of a shortage on the Danish market due to a very significant increase in exports of the products in question.

2. The regulation of the Commission has been drawn up on the basis of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2603/69 on the establishment of common rules for exports (3). In conformity with Article 6 of this Regulation, the Commission must, after adoption of an emergency measure, propose the appropriate measures for the Council to take.

It is therefore proposed that the Council adopt the following Regulation.

PROPOSAL FOR A COUNCIL REGULATION
maintaining the Danish export regime for aluminium waste and scrap

THE COMMISSION OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2603/69 establishing common rules for exports (1), and in particular Article 6 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas under Regulation (EEC) No 2915/82 of 28 October 1982 (2) the Commission gave Denmark the urgent authorisation to suspend delivery of export licences for aluminium waste and scrap under sub-heading No 76.01 B of the Common Customs Tariff;

Whereas in conformity with Article 6 of the above-mentioned Regulation 2603/69 the Commission must submit to the Council, after the adoption of the emergency measures, the appropriate provisions to be taken by the Council;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The Danish export regime for aluminium waste and scrap falling within subheading 76.01 B of the Common Customs Tariff adopted by Commission Regulation (EEC) No 2915/82 is applicable until 31 December 1982.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
