EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

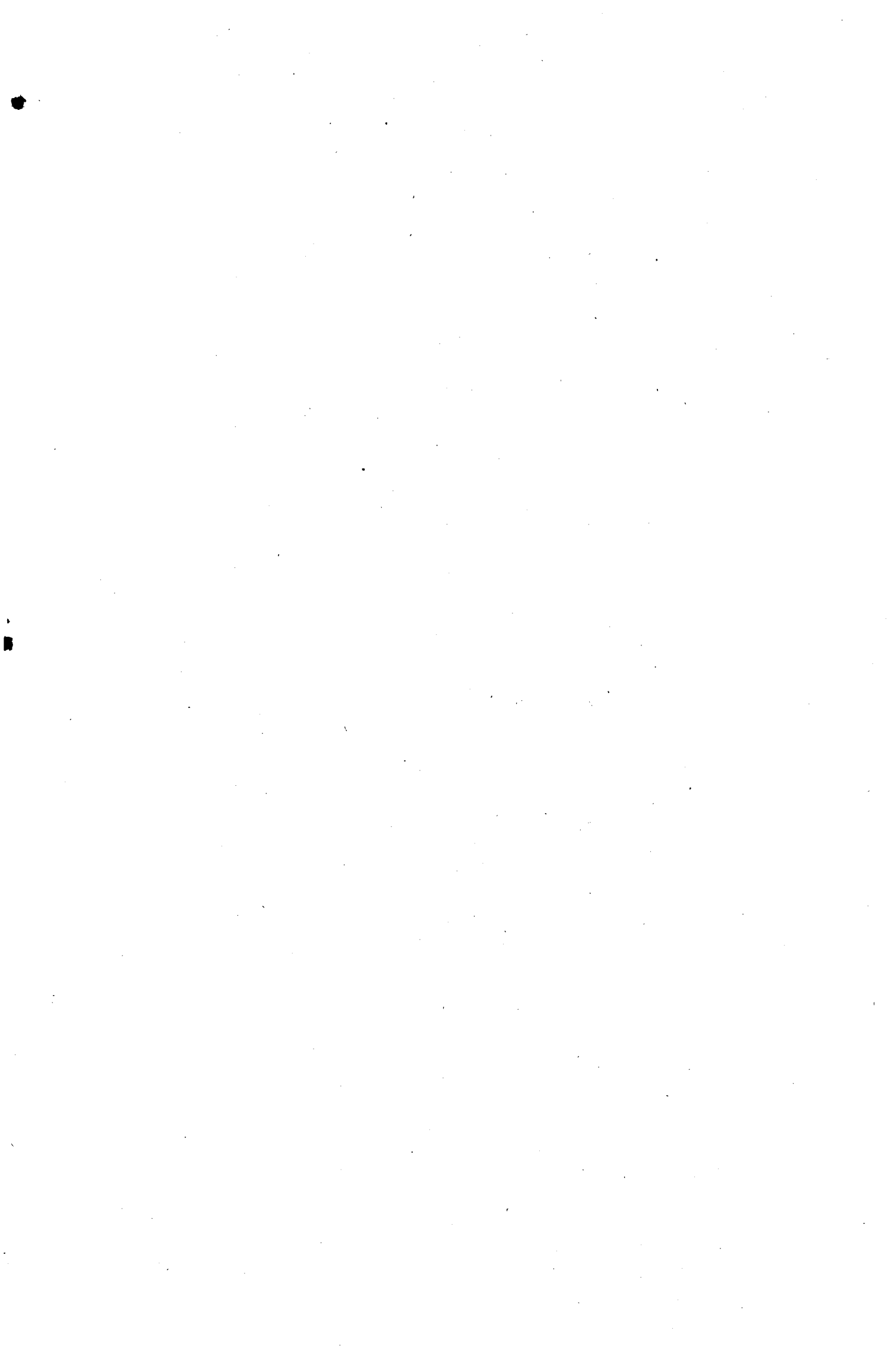
This draft regulation is intended to extend, for the months of November and December in the 1980/81 marketing year, the standard amount by which the levy on untreated olive oil originating in and coming from Greece is reduced; it amounted to 0.60 ECU/100 kg in 1979/80.

The standard amount is extended for only two months as Greece will accede to the Community on 1 January 1981.

The standard amount is intended to give preference to Greek oil on the Community market compared with other oils from non-member countries.

The Council's attention should be drawn to the requirement to consult Greece pursuant to Article 3(3) of Council Regulation (EEC) No 2749/78 of 23 November 1978 on trade in oils and fats between the Community and Greece.

The measures provided for in this Regulation do not involve any additional expenditure.



Proposal for a
COUNCIL REGULATION (EEC)

amending Regulation (EEC) No 2381/79 on the standard amount for unprocessed olive oil produced entirely in Greece and transported directly from that country into the Community

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2749/78 of 23 November 1978 on trade in oils and fats between the Community and Greece⁽¹⁾, and in particular Article 3 (3) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas Regulation (EEC) No 2749/78 provides for the fixing of a standard amount by which the levy applicable to Greek olive oil imported into the Community must be reduced;

Whereas Greece is to accede to the Community on 1 January 1980 and the standard amount in question should therefore be fixed only for the months of November and December of the 1980/81 marketing year;

Whereas Greece has been consulted pursuant to Article 3 (3) of Regulation (EEC) No 2749/78,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 2381/79 is hereby replaced by the following text :

Article 2

For the months of November and December 1980, the standard amount referred to in Article 3(1) of Regulation (EEC) No 2749/78 shall be 0.6 ECU per 100 kilograms of imported product."

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following that of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

It shall apply with effect from 1 November 1980.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
