Jacques-René Rabier was born in Paris on September 16, 1919.

1970 Appointment to Director-General for the Press and Information Service of the Commission of the European Communities.

M. Rabier has done research in political science, in the social sciences, on European integration, and on problems concerning information. He lectures at the Free University of Brussels (Université Libre de Bruxelles).
