 - 1952-1957 : Studied at "Ecole Polytechnique" of the University of Brussels. Graduated as mechanical & electrical engineer. Post-Graduate in nuclear physics at same University.
- Past Positions :
 - 1958-1959 : Reserve Officers' School - Corps of Signals - Assigned by Ministry of Defence to Belgian Nuclear Research Centre of Mol (SCK-CEN) - Work on computer simulation
 - 1959-1963 : Worked as civilian employee at same Centre. Successively engineer in the Reactor Studies Department, Head of Reactor Dynamics Group, Head of Section for Advanced Projects.
 - 1964-1969 : Senior engineer in Future Programmes Directorate, European Launcher Development Organization (ELDO), Paris. Work on space applications of nuclear power, nuclear rocket propulsion, isotopic power generators, and other advanced propulsion systems.
 - 1967-1969 : Also Consultant to the Nuclear Energy Agency of the OECD (Paris) on problems associated with the terrestrial use of isotopic batteries.
 - 1969-1974 : Transferred to the European Space Research Organization (ESRO), Paris. Successively Mission Manager for Telecommunications Satellites, Assistant Director for Applications Satellites (Telecommunications, Meteorology, Remote Sensing, Air & Sea Navigation), and Director for Telecommunications.
 - 1974-1981 : Joined the Commission of European Communities, Brussels, as Director of Programmes of the Joint Research Centre (JRC). Responsible for overall programming of research activities of the 4 Establishments of the JRC.

 - Since 1981: Commission of European Communities, Director for Science & Technology Policy, Coordination and Cooperation with Third Countries.
