

ROLLMAN, Tony: Director, Market Division

Born 1899. Luxembourg national.

1921: Becomes official of ARBED, the big Luxembourg steel combine.

1926 - In Far Eastern offices of ARBED.
1935

1935: Recalled to Luxembourg to be head of division of International Steel Entente.

1937: In charge of all sales for ARBED's steel wire products in Ghent.

In Ghent throughout war.

Late 1944 On return of Luxembourg Government, appointed official representative in Brussels (extremely important post from Luxembourg point of view as it dealt with all vital imports, in particular imports of foodstuffs.)

Duties in Ghent continued at the same time.

1947: Worked in Paris on the preparations for the Marshall Plan, as rapporteur on Steel Committee.

From 1948 With ECE in Geneva, first as chairman and then as full-time director of augmented Steel Committee for whole of Europe. Left ARBED.

Study on "Development and Prospects of the European Steel Industry in the World Steel Market" published in English and French by ECE, November 1949.

1950: Returned to ARBED to organise new political economy division of which he subsequently became director. Toured the world in that capacity in 1951.

1952: Took up duties as Director of Market Division on establishment of High Authority of European Coal and Steel Community.
