- 27 May 1914 Born in Brussels . Married with one child.
- Graduated as a civil construction engineer from the University of Louvain.
- Successively engineer, Director, and counsellor - Head of the Chemical Industries Department of the Belgian Ministry for Economic Affairs.
- Professor of Industrial Technology and Commercial Products.
- 1945-1946 Delegate of the Belgian Government to the Fertilizer Committee of the EEC in London and to the Fertilizer Committee of the Emergency Food Council in Washington, respectively.
- 1946-1947 President of the Chemical Products Committee of the Tripartite Economic Cooperation Council (France, Holland, Belgium-Luxembourg Economic Union).
- 1948 Vice-President (since 1953 President) of the Chemical Products Committee of the OEEC in Paris.
- 1949-1952 Vice-President (1952-1955 President) of the Union of Engineering Graduates of the University of Louvain.
- July-August 1955 President of a mission sent by the Chemical Industry to the Belgian Congo.
- 1958 Appointed to the staff of the Euratom Commission.
- He is also the author of a number of publications on European subjects.
