

## **BIOGRAPHY**

**Reinhard SCHULTE-BRAUCKS graduated in law and received the degree of Doctor of Law from the University of Göttingen, Germany and that of Master of Laws from the University of Berkeley, California.**

**After having worked as a lawyer in Munich, Dr. Schulte-Braucks joined the Commission of the European Communities in 1981 and worked in the Directorate General of Competition dealing with cases of restricted practices and abuse of dominant positions in a number of sectors including telecommunications.**

**In 1986, he moved to the Cabinet of Mr. Narjes, Vice-President of the EC Commission, responsible for industrial policy, research and development and telecommunications policy.**

**In January 1989, Mr. Schulte-Braucks joined the Commission's Directorate for telecommunications policy where he is responsible for regulatory matters concerning the liberalization and harmonization of telecommunications services.**
