

### Christiane SCRIVENER

Christiane SCRIVENER entered the European Parliament in 1979, was re-elected in 1984, and sits as a member of the Liberal Group. She belongs to the Union pour la Democratie (U.D.F.). Member of the Budgetary Committee, she was Rapporteur for the 1984 Community Budget. Vice-Chairman of the "Kangaroo Group", she has been involved in the work of persuasion that is essential for the creation of the single market.

As Secretary of State for Consumer Affairs in the government of President Valery Giscard d'Estaing (1976-1978) she put through an important legislative programme in the fields of consumer information and protection, and to strengthen regulation governing competition in economic affairs.

In her separate role as businesswoman, she has been heavily involved since 1958 in organising French technical cooperation with more than a hundred countries, in developing international technical and industrial exchanges, and in promoting French technology abroad.

A graduate of the Harvard Business School (year of 1966), she first studied law, literature and psychology at the University of Paris.

She is the author of several works :

- Europe, a battle for the future (1984)
- The role and the responsibility of publicity towards the public (1978)
- Stories of the little Troll (1986)

She is a Chevalier of the Legion of Honour (1978) and in 1976 she received the "Alumni Achievement Award" of the Harvard Business School Association. Her favourite sport is skiing, her preferred pastime music.
