

Petrus Josephus Servetius Serrarens

Mr. Serrarens, 64, was born at Dordrecht, Holland. A lawyer by training, has devoted considerable attention to social, economic and political problems, as parliamentarian, former secretary-general of the International Confederation of Christian Trade Unions, consultant to the Economic and Social Council of the United Nations and the International Labor Office, and President of the Social Affairs Commission of the Council of Europe. Is the author of studies on the growth of Nazi Germany and Communist Russia, also books on Austria, unemployment and colonial resources. Was appointed President of the first chamber of the Court of Justice in 1952.
