He has held several different posts within the services of the Commission and worked for almost seven years for the European Parliament.

He was responsible for press and information activities in the Copenhagen office of the Commission during the two Danish referendums on the Maastricht treaty, before being posted to Washington in October 1993.

Mr. Sondergaard is married with 6 children. His wife, Patricia, is a teacher.
