REGULATION (EEC) OF THE COUNCIL

laying down, for the 1975/1976 wine-growing year, the price to be paid for alcohol delivered to intervention agencies under the obligation to destil the by-products of wine-making, and the maximum amount of the contribution towards this price by the Guarantee Section of the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund

EXPLANATORY NOTE
=====

The aim of this Regulation is to fix, for the 1975/76 wine-growing year, and in accordance with the provisions of Article 24(3) of Regulation (EEC) No. 816/70, the price to be paid for alcohol delivered to intervention agencies under the obligation to distil by-products of wine-making, and to determine the maximum amount of the contribution towards these expenses by the Guarantee Section of the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund.

The Commission must take into account its proposal to set up a voluntary preventative distillation, and if necessitated-obligatory, at a withdrawal price equal to 50 % of the lowest guide price. It is for this reason that the Commission proposes to maintain the same conditions relating to price and amount of EAGGF contribution as were fixed for the 1974/75 wine-growing year by Regulation (EEC) No. 1878/74 as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No. 1349/75;

These conditions are the following :

- price of alcohol 0,80 UA/°/hl
- maximum amount of contribution by EAGGF :
 - in the case of products with an alcoholic strength of more than 52° but not more than 95°, 0 U.A. per hectolitre/degree of alcohol
- maximum amount of contribution by EAGGF
 - in the case of products with an alcoholic strength of more than 95°, 0,10 U.A. per hectolitre/degree of alcohol.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 816/70⁽¹⁾ of 28 April 1970 laying down additional provisions for the common organization of the market in wine, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 678/75⁽²⁾, and in particular Article 24(3), second subparagraph thereof ;

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission ;

Whereas in accordance with Article 24 of Regulation (EEC) No 816/70 and Article 1 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 1877/74⁽³⁾ of 15 July 1974 on the distillation of the by-products of wine-making, the Council must fix, for each wine-growing year, the price to be paid for alcohol delivered to intervention agencies under the obligation to distil the by-products of wine making and must fix the maximum amount of the contribution by the Guarantee

Section of the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund towards the costs devolving on these agencies ;

Whereas, in view of the amount of wine on the Community wine market, the average of the quotations for all table wines is close to or below the activating price ; whereas the price to be paid by the intervention agencies for alcohol delivered to them pursuant to the compulsory distillation of the by-products of wine-making should remain at the level for the 1974/75 wine-growing year ;

Whereas the maximum amount of the contribution of the Guarantee Section of the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund must be fixed under the conditions laid down in Article 4 of Regulation (EEC) No 1877/74 ;

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

1. For the 1975/76 wine-growing year, the price to be paid by the intervention agencies for the alcohol delivered to them under the obligation to distil the by-products of wine-making shall be 0.80 unit of account per hectolitre/degree of alcohol.

This price shall apply to rectified alcohol.

2. The maximum amount of the contribution by the Guarantee Section of the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund for the same year shall be :

- 0 unit of account per hectolitre/degree of alcohol for products exceeding 52° but not exceeding 95°,
- 0,10 unit of account per hectolitre/degree of alcohol for products exceeding 95°.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
