

Evolution of inland deliveries of unleaded motor spirit



For EUR 12^(*) the proportion of unleaded fuel rose from 40,5 % of all motor fuels in 1991 to 46,7 % in 1992. Although the market can quickly change, there remains a clear difference between Northern and Southern Europe with no southern country showing unleaded deliveries of more than 20 % . The use of unleaded continues to rise rapidly in all Member States (on average by 17 %). Germany^(*) is still the biggest user of unleaded at 80 % and in fact 50 % of all unleaded fuel deliveries in EUR 12 are to Germany.




