
### PIG POPULATION IN AUGUST 1993

and preliminary estimates of gross indigenous production

#### Marked increase in the pig population

The pig population in the European Community has increased considerably, as shown by the latest results of the surveys carried out in the Member States in August this year. There are a total of 111.65 million pigs. This is 2.86 million or +2.6% more than in the April survey. Except in Spain, where numbers fell slightly by -0.2%, numbers increased in all Member States, although to varying degrees. The largest increase was in Belgium with +10.6%, followed by Denmark (+7.9%) and Portugal (+7.2%). In the United Kingdom pig numbers increased by 4.5%, and there was a 2.9% increase in both Italy and Greece. In Luxembourg numbers rose by 3.0%, while in the Netherlands and Ireland there were only slight increases of 0.2% and 0.5% respectively. For France, where contrary to Community provisions no survey was carried out in August, the figures were estimated in the light of the trends in the other Member States, giving an increase of 121 000 pigs compared with April, i.e.

+0.9%. In Germany there was an increase in pig numbers of 1.6% or 420 000 animals compared with April.



#### Large numbers of fattening pigs

Fattening pigs, which represent a third of the total population and numbers of which increased by 7.7% compared with April, were the main reason for the steep increase in pig numbers in the Union. Piglet numbers rose by 1%, while young pigs rose only slightly by 0.3%. The number of covered sows, which is important for the future development of the population, even showed a decrease of 3.2%.

## Numbers continue to fall in the new Federal Länder

The 1.6% increase in the pig population in Germany as a whole is the outcome of opposing trends in the old and new Länder: while numbers increased by 2.3% or 506 000 animals in the old Länder, they again fell in the new Länder, this time by

2.1% or 86 000 animals. After a slight recovery in pig numbers in the new Länder in December of last year, it would seem that the downward trend there is continuing. The total number of pigs on the territory of the former GDR is now 4.043 million, representing 18% of the total pig population in Germany.



## Gross indigenous production remains high

Gross indigenous production is likely to be 176.610 million pigs for the period August 1993 to July 1994 according to the results of the preliminary estimates for the various Member States. However, the figures are more unreliable than usual since the available external trade figures, which are required in addition to the population returns, were incomplete owing to the change in the recording of data on intra-trade. Even so, it can still be assumed that production will reach a new record level. For the period August 1993 to July 1994, gross indigenous production is set to exceed

last year's already very high results by 0.5% or 896 000 animals. Broken down into two-month periods, gross indigenous production for August/September, with a total of 28.951 million pigs, is 3.9% up on last year's figure. For October/November 30.235 million pigs are expected and for December and January 1994 as many as 31.888 million. A downward trend in gross indigenous production looks unlikely to start before February/March of next year, with 29.193 million pigs (see diagram). 28.255 million is the estimate for April/May and 28.089 million for June/July 1994. Despite a slight decrease, gross indigenous production will continue to be very high.



As for production in the individual Member States, the greatest increase is due to take place in France, with +1.072 million pigs. Then comes the Netherlands with +757 000, followed by Denmark and Belgium with +355 000 and +338 000 respectively. An increase of 169 000 is expected for Ireland and 46 000 for the United Kingdom. By contrast, gross indigenous production in Spain is set to fall by more than a million animals. Large decreases are also expected for Germany with -667 000. The same applies, although to a lesser extent, to Greece (-93 000) and Italy (-87 000).

#### Continuing crisis in the pigmeat sector

The crisis affecting the EC pigmeat market is still much in evidence and there are so far no signs of an improvement. For the first time in several years, prices for slaughtered pigs dropped below ECU 100 per 100 kg. In July 1993, the price was ECU 109 per 100 kg and during the period from July to October 1993, it fell by about ECU 10 per 100 kg to reach, at the end of October, ECU 93 per 100 kg, which is 49.03% of the basic price. In July 1992, prices were 41% higher than in the same period of 1993.

This situation is the result of two main factors:

- a Europe-wide structural crisis in the pigmeat sector due to supply growing faster than demand: while Europe has come to suffer a chronic pigmeat surplus, output continues to rise;

- a worrying animal health situation in the EC: this is a short-term phenomenon that has been an obstacle to trade between the EC Member States since April 1993.

The market surplus and the low prices already prevailing in the first quarter of the year made it necessary to introduce private storage aid measures from the end of March 1993 for a period of six to seven months. The measures were brought to a halt in mid-June, by which time 67 000 tonnes of pigmeat had been stored.

A major short-term difficulty - a strike in the Danish slaughterhouses, which threw the EC market into disarray - prompted the Commission in June to grant a special refund for the export of 30 000 tonnes of carcasses to non-traditional markets (the countries of the former Soviet Union).

The continuing disarray in the marketplace prompted the adoption of another special refund in October covering the same quantities to the same countries.

Despite the Commission's action, prices continue to fall. The markets will again come under heavy strain in coming months, particularly as a result of the worrying animal health situation in several EC countries (Germany, Belgium, Spain and Portugal) and the abundant supply of pigmeat throughout the winter.
