Sheep and goat populations in December 1992 and forecast of gross indigenous production

Slight increase in sheep population

After a drastic fall in the sheep population in the European Community in 1991 (98 368 000 head), numbers recovered slightly in 1992 to 99 142 000, which represents an increase of 0.8% or 774 000 head over 1991. In individual Member States there were widely differing trends. With +3.9% the Netherlands recorded the highest growth rate, followed by Greece with +2.8%. In Ireland the sheep population rose by 2.3%, while in the United Kingdom and Spain, which together have more than 50% of the sheep in the Community, numbers rose by 1.9% and 0.7% respectively. Sheep numbers dropped sharply in Denmark (-16.4%). In Germany the sheep population fell by 7.6% and in France by 1.3%. Portugal recorded a drop of 0.9%. In Italy there was a slight drop of just 0.3%.

Market situation

In 1992, the market situation in the sheepmeat and goatmeat sectors was affected by two important factors, namely the abolition of the variable slaughtering premium in the United Kingdom and hence of the claw-back and, on the monetary front, the upheavals in the fourth quarter of the year.

The abolition of the variable premium resulted in a spectacular upswing in the UK market price (92/91 = 16.5 %), which triggered a rise in the average Community market price in the first quarter (92/91 = 3.3%). From April onwards, the continental market began to feel the effect of the ending of claw-back, particularly in France where prices fell by 3%. In the latter market also, sheep products from the other Member States faced sharper competition from meat imported from the United Kingdom. Ireland (92/91 = 9.8%) suffered most from this pressure which was aggravated, at the end of the year, by the upheavals on the currency front in general and the devaluation of the pound sterling in particular.

The situation hardly seems to be improving in 1993, with a year-on-year deterioration in prices, in the first two months, depending on the week, of 13-22% compared with 1992. Two crumbs of comfort, in this context, are the facts that prices at the beginning of 1992 were relatively high while the devaluations of certain national currencies, vis-à-vis the green rates, resulted in a "mathematical" reduction of the Community price by approximately 12%. Since the beginning of March, moreover, there have been signs of prices picking up.

Finally, it should be noted that changes in the common organization of the market (introduction of individual limits per producer and new definition of eligible ewes and sheep-goats) entering into force in 1993, may well persuade the producers to modify the management of their flocks.
