THE WEEK AHEAD

The first Council of Ministers meeting under the French Presidency will be on Monday and Tuesday, when ministers of agriculture meet to discuss future development of the agricultural policy and the need for cost cutting. The Commission has urged the ministers to take action on the reform proposals which were discussed prior to the Athens Summit. The Commission plans to finalise price proposals for 1984-5 by the weekend of January 14 and 15.

FLASHBACK

BUDGET CONTRIBUTION: Mrs Margaret Thatcher said in a television interview that the British government would 'take steps to safeguard the position' if the rebate were not paid on the 1983 budget contribution before the end of the financial year.

TRADE WITH SOVIET UNION: The Community has removed the quantitative restrictions on trade with the Soviet Union which were introduced after martial law was imposed in Poland.
