on Parliament's agenda

The European Parliament,

- whereas Parliament may put questions to the Council and the Commission,
- concerned to improve its own efficiency and procedures,
- determined to act in an open, democratic manner,
- considering that the executive functions of the Bureau and the enlarged Bureau should be accountable to the Parliament as a whole,
- wishing to exert to the full its existing powers,

1. Instructs the Bureau to set aside half an hour on the agenda for the Friday of each part-session for the President, or her deputy from the Bureau, to answer questions from Members concerning parliamentary affairs;
2. Asserts that these sessions should be conducted under the procedures governing Question Time for the Commission and Council.

JUSTIFICATION

The President, Bureau and Quaestors will require notification of questions to assemble appropriate information.
