MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr NYBORG

pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure

on increasing the number of staff in DG II
of the European Parliament Secretariat

The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rules 113 and 114 of its Rules of Procedure,
 - having regard to the new requirements which have emerged as a result of the expansion of Parliament's activities,
 - noting the increase in the number of parliamentary bodies and, in particular, the creation in 1981 of a subcommittee on information, several working parties, a committee on the verification of credentials, a subcommittee on problems concerning women and a subcommittee on institutional problems, with no provision for staff to service and assist these bodies,
1. Stresses the urgent need to increase the number of staff in the Directorate-General for Committees and Inter-Parliamentary Delegations in the European Parliament's Secretariat by transferring posts from other directorates-general;
 2. Instructs the responsible authorities to consider how this could be achieved by the beginning of 1982;
 3. Calls therefore on its President to instruct the Bureau and the Committee on Budgets to consider this matter as soon as possible.
