MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mrs THEOBALD-PAOLI

pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure

on the human rights situation in Uganda

The European Parliament,

- A. seriously alarmed at the human rights situation in Uganda,
 - B. having learnt of several massacres of innocent civilians and of numerous other executions of civilians carried out by persons wearing military uniform,
 - C. anxious to see the Community promote peace, internal stability and the principle of no foreign intervention in the affairs of East Africa,
1. Welcomes the courage shown by the Ugandan press in reiterating these demands;
 2. Calls on the government of Uganda to shed as much light as possible on the massacres which took place on its territory and to take measures to prevent any recurrence of these massacres;
 3. Proposes that the Community as a whole and the individual Member States furnish all appropriate assistance to this end (political, technical and/or economic) to Uganda if the Ugandan Government so requests;
 4. Reminds Uganda of the special importance attached by the Community to respect of human rights in its relations with all countries in the world;
 5. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the government of Uganda, to the Commission, the Council and the governments of Member States.
