

COMMUNICATION FROM THE COMMISSION TO THE COUNCIL

concerning the final estimates for the 1976/77 wine-growing year

COM(78) 342 final



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Pursuant to Article 3 (3) of Regulation N° 24, "For each winegrowing year, and for the first time before 16 April 1971, the Commission shall provide the Council with final estimates of Community resources and uses in the preceding wine-growing year".

The final estimates for the 1976/77 wine-growing year are annexed to this Communication.

Compared with the 1975/76 estimates, it can be seen that :

- overall production increased by about 3.1 million hl ;
- imports from non-member countries increased by 0.5 million hl ;
- processing declined by about 0.4 million ha ;
- losses declined by 0.1 million hl ;

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- stocks at the end of the wine-growing year increased by about 3.8 million hl.

The Community harvest of 148 416 000 hl in the autumn of 1976 was 2 914 000 hl more than total domestic uses.

On the whole the harvest was of good quality.

Total domestic uses, including quantities distilled pursuant to Regulation (EEC) Nº 816/70, dropped by about 3.7 million hl.

Excluding the quantities affected by the distillation measures, total domestic uses declined by 6.8 million hl, of which 3.2 million hl for direct human consumption.
