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Breakdown of fixed capital assets

Tangible investments can be subdivided as follows:

- Land, buildings and existing structures:

Building sites and development sites, buildings and structures constructed before the year and purchased (or sold) during that same year, including land, buildings and structures for social purposes.

- Building and civil engineering:

Building (including building for social purposes), civil engineering work carried out during the survey year or in progress at the end of that year. Maintenance costs for buildings and other real property which the enterprise possesses or rents, excluding current maintenance costs.

- Transport:

Road, river, rail, marine and air transport; containers.

- Plant and equipment:

Heavy harbour equipment; handling equipment; other plant and equipment; office furniture and equipment, etc.



Only material goods (tangible investments) are considered (furniture, machinery and capital goods for offices and shops, etc; means of transport and commercial vehicles of any kind; expenditure on building construction, sites and premises purchased, etc.).

On the other hand, intangible capital investment (operations relating to the acquisition of rights over non-material goods, e.g. transport licences) and purchases of shares and transferable securities are excluded.

This heading also covers extensions, conversions, improvements and repairs which extend the normal life or increase the efficiency of existing fixed assets. Running repairs and maintenance, however, are not included.

By sale of fixed capital assets is meant the income received in the course of the survey year for the sale of fixed capital assets as defined above.

Method of evaluation

Goods acquired are valued at total cost price, i.e. at price including delivery, marked up to include installation costs and any fees and duties, but not including deductible VAT and the cost of financing. In order to estimate the cost of fixed capital assets produced on own account, and the cost of major repairs carried out, the expenditure shown (notional or actual) is that incurred in their production (or repair) during the survey year, including expenditure for the construction of premises and for buildings in the process of construction. This expenditure includes the cost of labour and raw materials and, where possible, the proportion of overheads relating to such work.

The evaluation of sales of fixed capital assets is made at actual price received (excluding VAT) and not at book value.

Notes:

The figures shown should, as far as possible, include the value of all fixed capital assets coming into the possession of the enterprise during the survey year, i.e. all fixed capital assets delivered to it, including, where appropriate expenditure for major repairs carried out; in the case of premises constructed for own account, expenditure shown (notional or actual) is that incurred during the year, irrespective of whether or not contruction has been completed.

If the survey unit bases its return on figures entered in its accounts, all those figures should be shown, which, in line with local tax requirements, have been entered during the survey year directly under the heading "capital investment or major repairs and maintenance", including instalment payments for plant in the course of construction (buildings, etc.) corresponding roughly to the state of progress of the work, but not payments on account or payments in full relating to capital investments to be delivered at a later date.

In the event of a merger, takeover or hiving-off of enterprises, investments and assets brought in are not included in purchases and sales of fixed capital assets.

5.1 Expenditure on sub-contracting operations relating to transport activities

Sub-contracting is that part of the transport service which one operator entrusts to another operator in the same sector. This may take the form of chartering, connections or any other service covered statutarily or by normal trade practice.

The amount of expenditure on sub-contracting operations should be entered at the actual price invoided by the subcontractor, exclusive of deductible VAT

5.2 Other expenditure for current purchases such as:

- purchases of goods for resale without further processing (enterprises of the transport sector having a secondary commercial activity)
- purchases of materials, consumables and supplies used in the enterprise: fuel, lubricants, tyres, spare parts for motor vehicles, supplies and small tools, packing material, office material, etc.)
- the purchase (from third parties) of services other than sub-contracting operations relating to transport services, e.g. maintenance and repair work (but not the value of the installation of fixed capital assets or major repairs entered along with investments); the costs of technical, legal and accounting assistance; insurance premiums; expenses for consultations and meetings; contributions to trade associations; postage, telegraph and telephone charges; advertising costs; costs of representatives; travelling and subsistence costs; brokerage commissions paid to persons not on the staff of the enterprise; bank charges (other than interests on borrowed capital),; information costs; rent of capital goods, vehicle fleets and non-residential buildings; electricity, gas and water charges relating to non-residential buildings, etc.

6. Purchases and sales of fixed capital assets (excluding VAT)

The second secon

Definition:

Accuisition of fixed capital assets includes expenditure on all new or used capital goods acquired in the course of the financial year (bought from other enterprises or produced on own account), having a useful life of more than one year and intended for the use of the enterprise.

As a rule, the valuation of stock is carried out in accordance with the normal stocktaking standards, excluding VAT.

If changes in stock are thought to be fairly negligible for small enterprises, this data could be recorded only in enterprises over a given size.

a) Generally speaking, the heading includes all stocks of products acquired as current purchases and coming into the possession of the enterprise, irrespective of their place of storage: stocks of products for resale (secondary trade activity) or for intermediate consumption by the enterprise (office equipment, packaging, cleaning, heating materials, fuel, etc.).



Out-of-pocket expenses paid by the enterprise on behalf of its customers and which the enterprise invoices to its customers at the exact rates charged are excluded (customs duties, sea-freight charges, etc.).

Operating subsidies received from public authorities or the Institutions of the European Communities are also excluded.

The concept of turnover in the transport sector is relatively complex. The total amount invoiced out by enterprises to their customers is of limited interest from the economic point of view, for this total includes the payment for transport services which the enterprise may have sub-contracted to another enterprise in the same sector: those <u>sub-contracting</u> operations are a phenomenon the volume of which is peculiar to the transport sector.

It is therefore useful to introduce the idea of

NET TURNOVER (OR NET RECEIPTS) - EXCLUSIVE OF VAT

taken as total turnover (exclusive of VAT) minus expenditure on sub-contracting operations relating to transport activities (see § 5.1)

A distinction may be made between:

4.1 Net receipts for the principal activity of transport

These are the receipts for the principal activity of transport, less payments made for transport work contracted out to other enterprises (see § 5.1).

4.2 Net receipts of other transport activities

These are the receipts for any secondary activities of transport carried out by the enterprise, less payments made for transport work contracted out to other enterprises (see \S 5.1).

4.3 Turnover relating to other transport activities

This heading covers receipts from secondary activities in industry, distributive trades or services, other than transport services.

5. Intermediate consumption

Intermediate consumption consists of the value of current purchases of goods and services made during the year (see below), plus value of stocks at the

⁽a) Transport is considered a "principal" or a "secondary" activity within the NACE 3 digit classification, reproduced in tables 1 to 3 of this document. If one enterprise undertakes several transport activities (e.g. rail transport, road transport of passengers and goods), the principal activity is that with the greatest added value (added value being judged on the basis of all the most appropriate criteria: e.g.: number of employees, turnover, etc.).



k) housing allowances paid in cash by employers to their employees.

The wages and salaries which employers temporarily continue to pay in the event of the sickness, maternity, industrial injury, disability, redundancy, etc. of their employees have to be included.

Gross wages and salaries do not include:

- a) expenditures by employers which are to their own benefit as well as to that of their employees, such as:
 - allowances or reimbursement of employees for travelling, separation, removal and entertainment expenses incurred in the course of their duties
 - expenditures on providing amenities at the place of work, medical examinations, supplying working clothes
 - current expenditures devoted to sporting or recreational facilities intended for employees
 - current expenditures on the transport of employees to and from work organised by their employers.
- b) allowances to employees for the purchase of tools, equipment or special clothing needed for their work, or that part of their wages or salaries which, under their contracts, employees are required to devote to such purchases.

These expenditures are included in the intermediate consumption of employers (see § 5)

3.2. Employers' social contributions

These contributions consist of the payments made by employers to insurers (social security funds, insurance enterprises, central or local government agencies in the case of civil servants), for the benefit of their employees. These payments cover statutory, conventional, contractual and voluntary contributions in respect of insurance against the risks of sickness, maternity, disability, old age and survivers, unemployment, industrial injuries and occupational diseases, and in respect of family allowances.

Although paid directly by employers to the insurers, these employers' contributions are treated as a component of the compensation of employees, who are deemed to pay them over to the insurers.

The social benefits paid directly (i.e. outside without any contributory scheme) by employers to their former employees and other eligible persons are to be included.

4. Total turnover (excluding VAT)

Definition:

"Turnover represents the amount invoiced by the enterprise for market sales and services rendered to third parties during the reference year. Turnover includes all duties and taxes which fall on products and services when they leave the enterprise with the exception of VAT invoiced by the producer to his customers. Price rebates, deferred discounts and allowances granted to the customers are deducted, but not cash discounts. Turnover does not include sales of fixed assets.

2.1 Employees

The term 'employees' is applied to workers engaged in the enterprises who have a contract of employment and whose remuneration is a function of time or piece of work. The number of employees corresponds to the total number of persons engaged minus the number of proprietors and family workers.

Manual workers, non-manual workers, persons working outside the unit (considered as a geographical entity) but who belong to it and are paid by it (vehicle or vessel crews) are therefore included in this category. This number includes persons absent for a short period (e.g. sick leave, annual leave, special leave) and also persons on strike, but excludes persons absent for an indefinite period. It also includes part-time workers (half-time or short-time) who are considered as such under the laws of the country concerned and are on the payroll, as well as seasonal workers and apprentices.

Home-workers (provided they are not employees included on the payroll of the enterprise), persons made available to the unit by other enterprises and charged for, persons carrying out maintenance or repair work in the survey unit on behalf of other enterprises and those doing their military service, are excluded.

3. Total expenses on personnel

These expenses include all payments in cash and in kind made by employers in remuneration for the work done by their employees (see § 2.1) during the relevant period.

These payments cover "gross remunerations" and "social security contributions paid by the employer".

3.1 Gross remunerations

Gross remunerations (a) include the following elements:

- a) basic wages and salaries
- b) enhanced rates of pay for overtime, nightwork, weekend work
- c) cost of living allowances, local allowances and expatriation allowances
- d) bonuses based on productivity of profits, Christmas and New Year bonuses '13 month' pay (annual supplementary pay) and others
- e) allowances for transport to and from work
- f) holiday pay for official holidays or annual holidays
- g) commissions, tips, attendance and directors fees paid to employees
- h) bonus shares distributed to employees
- i) payments made by employers to their employees under savings schemes
- j) remuneration in kind, i.e. goods and services, supplied free, or at reduced prices, to employees for their own consumption (food, drink, tobacco, fuels, housing, clothing and meals).

⁽a) Remunerations are described as gross because they are shown before the deduction of any social contributions payable by employees and any taxes on income deducted at source.

1. Enterprise

Definition: "The enterprise is a legally-defined organization which a) has its own balance sheet, b) is subject to a directing authority (which may be either a natural or a legal person) and c) has been formed to carry on in one or more places one or more activities for the production of goods or services."

- An enterprise may consist of a single producer unit in a geographically separate place or of several local units which are not legally autonomous and which belong to enterprises in question.
- Self-employed persons who have no fixed working premises or technical plant (e.g. inland waterway vessel operators ewners with no fixed address on land) are considered to be both enterprises and local units. A census of these persons will be made by the country in which the boat is registered.
- If an enterprise whose main activity lies in the transport sector has several local units some of which pursue activities outside the transport field, the data relating to the enterprise refer in principle to all the local units throughout the territory of a given country.

If an enterprise possesses local units situated in several countries as many "enterprise" units are counted as there are countries where these local units are established; in each country the "enterprise" units therefore comprise only the local units resident on the national territory. The notional enterprise (the resident part of an enterprise having its head office in another country) will be accounted for as an activity of local units situated within the national territory.

2. Total number of persons engaged

The number of persons engaged is defined as the total number of persons who work in the unit under consideration (including working proprietors, partners working regularly in the enterprise and unpaid family workers) and persons who work outside the unit (considered as a geographic entity), but who belong to it and are paid by it (vehicle crews in land transport enterprises, vessel or aircraft crews in air transport, inland water or sea enterprises). This number includes persons on leave for short periods (e.g. sick leave, annual leave, special leave) and also persons on strike, but excludes persons on leave for indefinite periods. Part-time workers (whether working half-time or short-time) who are considered as such under the laws of the country concerned and are on the payroll are also included, as well as seasonal workers and apprentices.

Home-workers , persons made available to the unit by other enterprises and charged for, persons carrying out repair and maintenance work in the unit under consideration on behalf of other enterprises and those doing their military service are not included.

GENERAL DATA

For the wholesale and retail distribution branches, the initial results of this attempted harmonization are presented in a series of booklets by country currently being published (a).

As regards the transport sector, the present document, which is intended for the relevant Commission departments and the members of the working parties on transport statistics, sets out the main data on enterprises currently available from the national statistical institutes.

These data generally refer to the years 1978/79: for some countries more recent data are already available, but they will be presented in a later document.

It is apparent that, even though it is limited to a small number of main data, this first document on transport enterprises in the Community still contains rather large gaps for certain activity groups and countries. The SOEC hopes that whenever the document is updated it will be possible to improve both the quantity and the quality of the data collected.

Introduction

For several years now the SOEC has been working towards the production of a set of comparable statistics on the structure and activity of enterprises operating in the Member States of the Community.

For the industrial sector, the compilation and regular publication of such statistics are already under way, based on methods laid down by a Council directive (a).

For the services sector, similar statistics are also planned, but their comilation is not based on binding legal instruments (Council regulations or directives). In view of the well-known difficulties of surveys in the tertiary sector and the rather substantial differences in the degree of development of the relevant statistics in the various Member States, the SOEC opted for gradual harmonization of the national statistics, endeavouring to make the best possible use of the considerable efforts to improve these statistics made by the national statistical institutes.

Thus, in cooperation with these institutes, the SCEC first of all established a general framework of common references (definitions, nomenclatures, classifications, etc.) which the national statistics should incorporate in order to ensure a sufficient degree of comparability between countries, although this is limited for the time being to the wholesale distribution, retail distribution and transport branches (b). The next step was to try to collect from the national statistical institutes data which comply as far as possible with the Community standards thus laid down.
