HIGH-LEVEL MEETING BETWEEN THE EEC AND NORWAY

There will be a high-level meeting between the EEC and Norway in Brussels on 28 June 1990. The Commission Delegation will be led by Mr Andriessen, Vice-President with special responsibility for external relations and trade policy whilst the Norwegian Delegation will be headed by Mr Kjell Magen Bondevik, Minister for Foreign Affairs who will be accompanied <u>inter alia</u>, by, Mrs Kaci Kullmann Five, Minister for Trade and the Merchant Marine.

The meeting will enable the two parties to exchange views on the most recent problems. Relations between the EEC and EFTA will be high on the agenda, as will internal changes in the Community and Norway, the Uruguay Round, the problems of Central and Eastern Europe — with special reference to the PHARE programme — and developments and prospects with regard to the European Economic Space in the light of the first meeting of the EEC-EFTA negotiations held in Brussels on 20 June.
