By letter of 26 February 1979, the President of the Council of the European Communities requested the European Parliament to deliver an opinion on the proposal from the Commission of the European Communities to the Council for a directive amending in respect of chilling, Directive 71/118/EEC on health problems affecting trade in fresh poultrymeat.

The President of the European Parliament referred this proposal to the Committee on the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Protection by letter of 8 March asking the committee to decide whether the simplified consultation procedure could be applied.

On 21 March 1979 the Committee on the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Protection appointed Mr LAMBERTS rapporteur.

It considered this proposal at its meeting of 2 April 1979 and decided unanimously to apply the simplified consultation procedure.
