By letter of 6 January 1978 the President of the Council of the European Communities asked the European Parliament to deliver its opinion on the draft from the Commission of the European Communities to the Council for a recommendation to the Member States regarding methods of evaluating the cost of pollution control to industry.

The President of the European Parliament referred this draft Commission recommendation to the Committee on the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Protection.

At its meeting of 22 February 1978 the committee appointed Mr W. MÜLLER rapporteur. At its meeting of 19 April 1978 it adopted the motion for a resolution unanimously.

MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

embodying the opinion of the European Parliament on the draft from the Commission of the European Communities to the Council for a recommendation to the Member States regarding methods of evaluating the cost of pollution control to industry

The European Parliament

- having regard to the draft from the Commission of the European Communities to the Council for a recommendation¹,
 - having been consulted by the Council (Doc. 484/77),
 - having regard to the report of the Committee on the Environment, Public Health and Consumer Protection (Doc. 85/78),
1. Approves the Commission's draft;
 2. Requests the Commission to report to the European Parliament at regular intervals on the basis of reports received from the Member States on progress made in harmonizing the evaluation of pollution control costs.
