By letter of 11 January 1977, the Political Affairs Committee requested authorization to draw up a report on the European Community's information policy.

The Political Affairs Committee hereby submits to the European Parliament the following motion for a resolution:

#### MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

on the European Community's information policy with regard to preparations for the first direct elections to the European Parliament

### The European Parliament,

- having regard to Amendment No. 4 (Doc. 457/76) to the 1977 draft budget to the effect that a total amount of 1 million u.a. should be entered in the budget and frozen until the Commission has submitted to the European Parliament for its approval a detailed programme of the information projects it intends to carry out in connection with direct elections,
- having regard to the interim report by the Political Affairs Committee (Doc. 526/76),
- Requests the Commission to submit its information programme in preparation for direct elections to the European Parliament before 30 March 1977;
- Points out that this programme cannot be considered in isolation from the Commission's normal information activities in which direct elections are regarded as the main priority;
- 3. Requests the Political Affairs Committee to draw up a report on this subject as soon as possible, and at the latest by the May 1977 part session dealing in particular with:
  - the place occupied by the Commission's intensified information programme in relation to its 1977 information programme as a whole,
  - what measures are being taken to ensure coordination of the information programmes of the Commission and the European Parliament in respect of direct elections.
- 4. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and Commission.
