## The European Parliament

- having regard to the failure of the United Nations Law of the Sea Conference to produce an international convention for ratification at its September session;
- having regard to the intention of some States including Iceland, Norway, the United States and Canada to extend unilaterally their fishing zones to 200 miles early in 1977;
- noting that the consequences will be severely detrimental to the fishing industries of the Community if the Community States fail to extend their fishing zones to 200 miles;
- convinced of the need for Member States of the Community to take immediate action;
- Calls upon the Council of the Communities to agree an extension of the Community Member States' fishing zones to 200 miles by January 1977;
- Calls upon the Commission to open discussions on fishing agreements with non-Community nations, and to begin immediately negotiations with Iceland concerning the British fishing agreement which ends on 30 November;
- 3. Calls upon the Commission to take the initiative in calling for a conference of Ministers from Community Member States and our European neighbours in the Council of Europe to discuss the social, political and economic problems that will arise from a unilateral European extension of fishing zones.
