By letter of 23 October 1975, the President of the Council of the European Communities requested the European Parliament to deliver an opinion on the proposal from the Commission of the European Communities to the Council for a decision on European Social Fund measures to aid vocational adaptation operations.

In anticipation of official referral by the President of the European Parliament, the Committee on Social Affairs and Employment appointed Mr Adams rapporteur at its meeting of 30 October 1975.

It considered the proposal at its meeting of 30 October 1975 and adopted the motion for a resolution unanimously with 2 abstentions.
