INTERIM REPORT

drawn up on behalf of the Committee on Budgets

on the draft annual accounts of the European Parliament for the financial year 1973 (1 January – 31 December 1973)

Rapporteur: Mr Heinrich AIGNER

Pursuant to Rule 50 A(2) of the Rules of Procedure the President of the European Parliament forwarded to the Committee on Budgets the draft annual accounts ('Report on the administrative expenditure') of the European Parliament for the financial year 19.73 (1 January to 31 December 1973).

At its meeting of 4 March 1974 the Committee on Budgets appointed as rapporteur Mr Aigner, the rapporteur on the estimates for 1973.

The Committee on Budgets considered the report at its meeting of 24 April 1974, at which it also considered and unanimously adopted the draft interim report.

The following were present: Mr Aigner, acting chairman and rapporteur; Mr Rossi, vice-chairman; Mr Concas, Durand, Gerlach, Notenboom, Pêtre, Pounder, Schmidt and Wieldraaijer.

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The Committee on Budgets hereby submits to the European Parliament the following motion for a resolution, together with explanatory statement:

MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

on the draft annual accounts of the European Parliament for the financial year 1973 (1 January - 31 December 1973)

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the interim report of the Committee on Budgets (Doc. 66/74);
- 1. Points out that the appropriations available for the financial year 1973 amounted to 26,925,433.12 u.a., of which 25,564,625 u.a. are entered in its budget for the financial year 1973 and 1,360,808.12u.a. are automatically carried forward from the financial year 1972 to 1973.

2. Notes:

- (a) that the commitments of expenditure entered into up to 31.12.1973 for the financial year 1973 amount to 23,044,199.11 u.a.;
- (b) that the payments made in respect of the financial year 1973 by 31.12.73 amount to 21,199,568.10 u.a.;
 - that payments made under the special decision of the Council authorizing the closure of operations for the financial year 1973 on 15.1.74 amount to 233,765.89 u.a.;
- (c) that the sums still unpaid at the close of the financial year 1973 amount to 1,597,465.12 u.a.;
 - that the corresponding appropriations are automatically carried forward;

3. Decides that:

- (a) the unused appropriations of 206,686.30 u.a. automatically carried forward from the financial year 1972 to 1973 shall be cancelled pursuant to Article 202 of the EEC Treaty;
- (b) the unused available appropriations for 1973 amounting to 2,520,425.89 u.a. shall be cancelled;
- 4. Defers its final decision on the discharge in respect of the financial year 1973 (to be taken pursuant to Article 50A (2) and (3) of the Rules of Procedure) until the accounts have been checked by the audit bodies of the Community under the conditions laid down in the Treaty.

5. Instructs its President to forward this resolution and the report of its committee to the Commission of the Communities.

EXPLANATORY STATEMENT

1. On the basis of the new financial regulation applicable to the Budget of the European Communities, the Commission will prepare a management account of the Communities by 1 June at the latest.

The Community institutions must therefore forward the necessary information to the Commission by 1 May.

- 2. The Committee on Budgets is submitting an interim report to Parliament so that it can take official note of the closure of its accounts.
- 3. On the basis of this interim report, Parliament will also decide on the cancellation of certain appropriations:
- (a) unused appropriations carried forward from the previous financial year (pursuant to the Financial Regulation);
- (b) unused appropriations available for the current financial year.
- 4. Finally, on the basis of this interim report, Parliament will decide to pronounce on final adoption of the accounts at a later date.

As laid down in Article 50A (2) and (3) of the Rules of Procedure, this decision will be taken on the basis of the report of the appropriate committee, and it is also on the basis of this report that Parliament will decide on the final discharge to its President and Secretary-General.

This report will be submitted to Parliament after the latter and its appropriate committee have examined the accounts checked by the audit bodies provided for in the Treaty and the Audit Board's report on these accounts.

B. COMMENTS CONCERNING THE PRINCIPAL VARIATIONS IN EXPENDITURE RECORDED IN RELATION TO THAT OF THE PRECEDING FINANCIAL YEAR

The appropriations used in 1973 showed an average increase of 53% over the expenditure for the previous financial year, as a result of the increase in Parliament's work (11 part-sessions in 1973 and in 1972; 298 meetings of the various committees in 1973 compared with 286 in 1972); the greater number of delegates following the accession of the new member countries (208 in 1973, 142 in 1972); the increase in staff (1,086 posts approved in 1973, 646 in 1972); and the well-known phenomenon of the rise in the cost of living; for example, the prices of fuel oil (Article 212) and paper (Article 230) rose by 88% and 35% respectively during the year. More detailed explanations are given below.

CHAPTER 11 - Staff

Increase 4,144,200 u.a.

The appropriations for the present financial year have had to cover the cost of two adjustments in remuneration, the latest of these having been approved by the Council on 28 December 1973. These changes mean an average increase of 15% depending on grade.

CHAPTER 12 - Allowances and expenses on entering and on leaving the service and on transfer Increase 376,500 u.a.

The increase in staff has also affected costs of newspaper advertisements, candidates' travel expenses, etc.

CHAPTER 13 - Expenditure relating to missions and duty travel

Increase 290,900 u.a.

This increase is attributable to the greater number of missions and the rise in transport costs as well as the increase in staff.

CHAPTER 14 - Expenditure on social welfare and on further vocational training of staff Increase 48,900 u.a.

The organization of language courses (particularly for the new official languages) for parliamentarians and staff of the Secretariat is an important factor in this increase.

CHAPTER 15 - Cost or organizing internal training courses

Increase 21,900 u.a.

These training courses for student translators and interpreters were organized for the first time in 1973.

CHAPTER 21 - Rental of buildings and incidental expenditure

Increase 915,900 u.a.

This chapter covers appropriations for the occupation of new buildings, originally provided for in Chapter 99. The rent for the new buildings in Luxembourg, Strasbourg and Brussels, and particularly furnishing and fitting costs, has greatly affected this expenditure.

CHAPTER 22 - Movable property and ancillary expenses

Increase 316,000 u.a.

This increase is due to the purchase of more machinery, equipment and technical facilities (including the transportable equipment for simultaneous interpretation) as a result of the considerable increase in work.

CHAPTER 23 - Current administrative expenditure

Increase 361,500 u.a.

This chapter has been directly affected by the increased work-load, for example postal charges and telecommunications (Art. 231)

CHAPTER 27 - Expenditure on publishing and information

Increase 270,600 u.a.

The total number of documents printed has increased because of distribution to the new member countries and translation into six languages instead of four.

CHAPTER 37 - Expenditure relating to certain institutions - other expenditure

Increase 360,800 u.a.

There has been a considerable increase in the expenditure provided for under the association between the EEC and the AASM and the costs of the political groups' secretariats.

CHAPTER 41 - Subsidies and financial contributions

The number of groups of visitors has increased due to the accession of the new member states.

Increase 53,100 u.a.
