amending the resolution of 11 March 1974 concerning the number and membership of Parliamentary committees

## The European Parliament,

- having regard to Rule 37 of its Rules of Procedure,
- considering that in the present circumstances it would be useful to strengthen the parliamentary bodies responsible for questions connected with the associated Mediterranean countries that are potential Member States of the Community,

## Has decided:

- 1. to set up an Associations Committee, with 35 members, from whom it will appoint delegations to the Joint Parliamentary Committees, and which will be responsible for all relations with all associated third countries that are potential Member States of the Community;
- 2. to amend the resolution of 11 March 1974 accordingly, with effect from 11 March 1975.
