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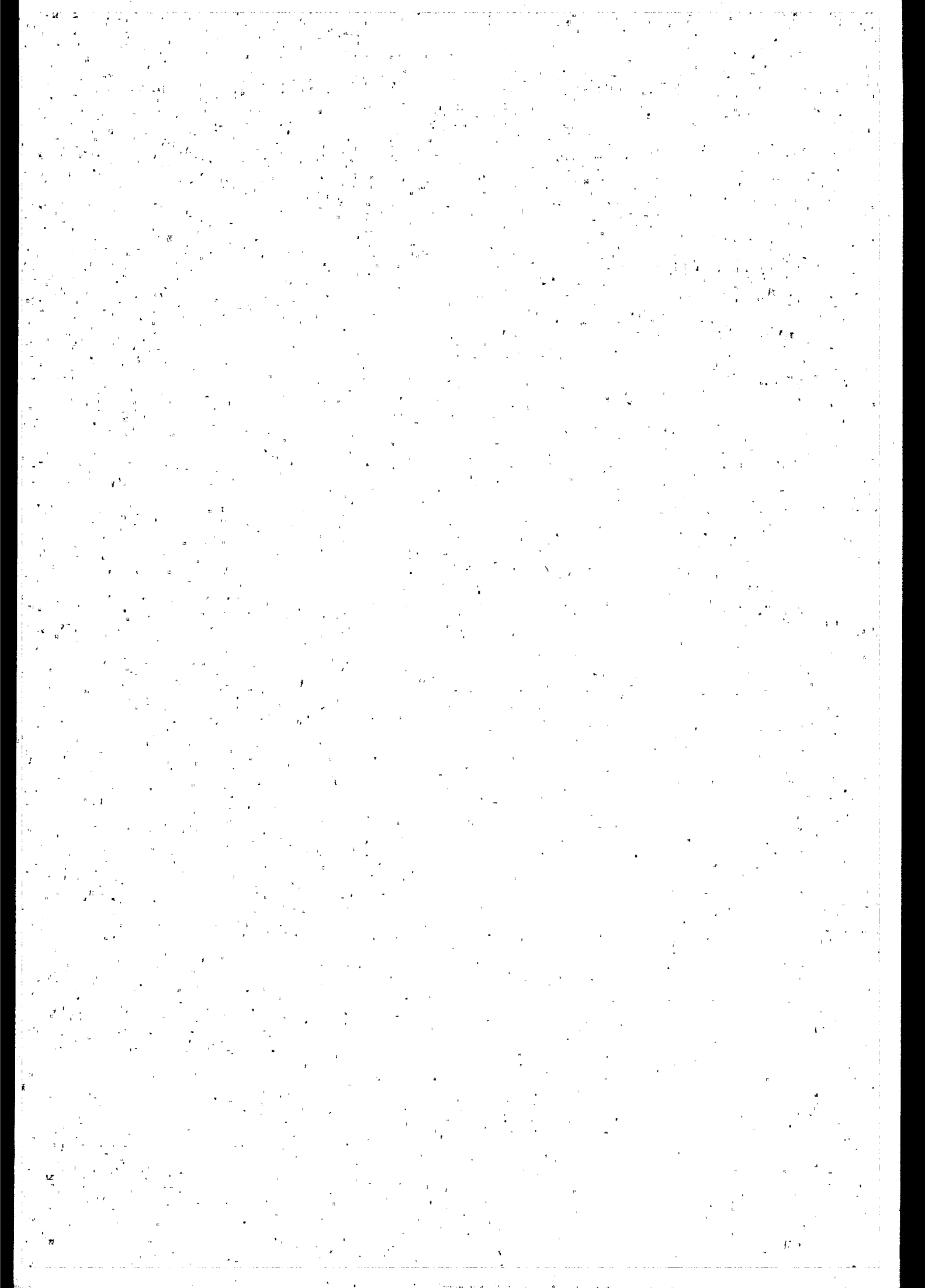

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

1. The subject of the following draft regulation is the temporary Common Customs Tariff duty suspension for mechanically propelled aircraft of an unladen weight exceeding 15 000 kg falling within subheading ex 88.02 B II c)
2. The Commission thinks that in view of the international negotiations about duty concessions in this sector a duty suspension for only 6 months should be adopted.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 28 thereof,

From 1 January to 30 June 1978, the autonomous Common Customs Tariff duty for mechanically propelled aircraft of an unladen weight exceeding 15 000 kilograms, falling within subheading ex 88.02 B II c) shall be totally suspended.

Article 2

Having regard to the draft Regulation submitted by the Commission,

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 January 1978.

Whereas the autonomous duty on mechanically propelled aircraft of an unladen weight exceeding 15 000 kilograms should be totally suspended for the period 1 January to 30 June 1978,

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
