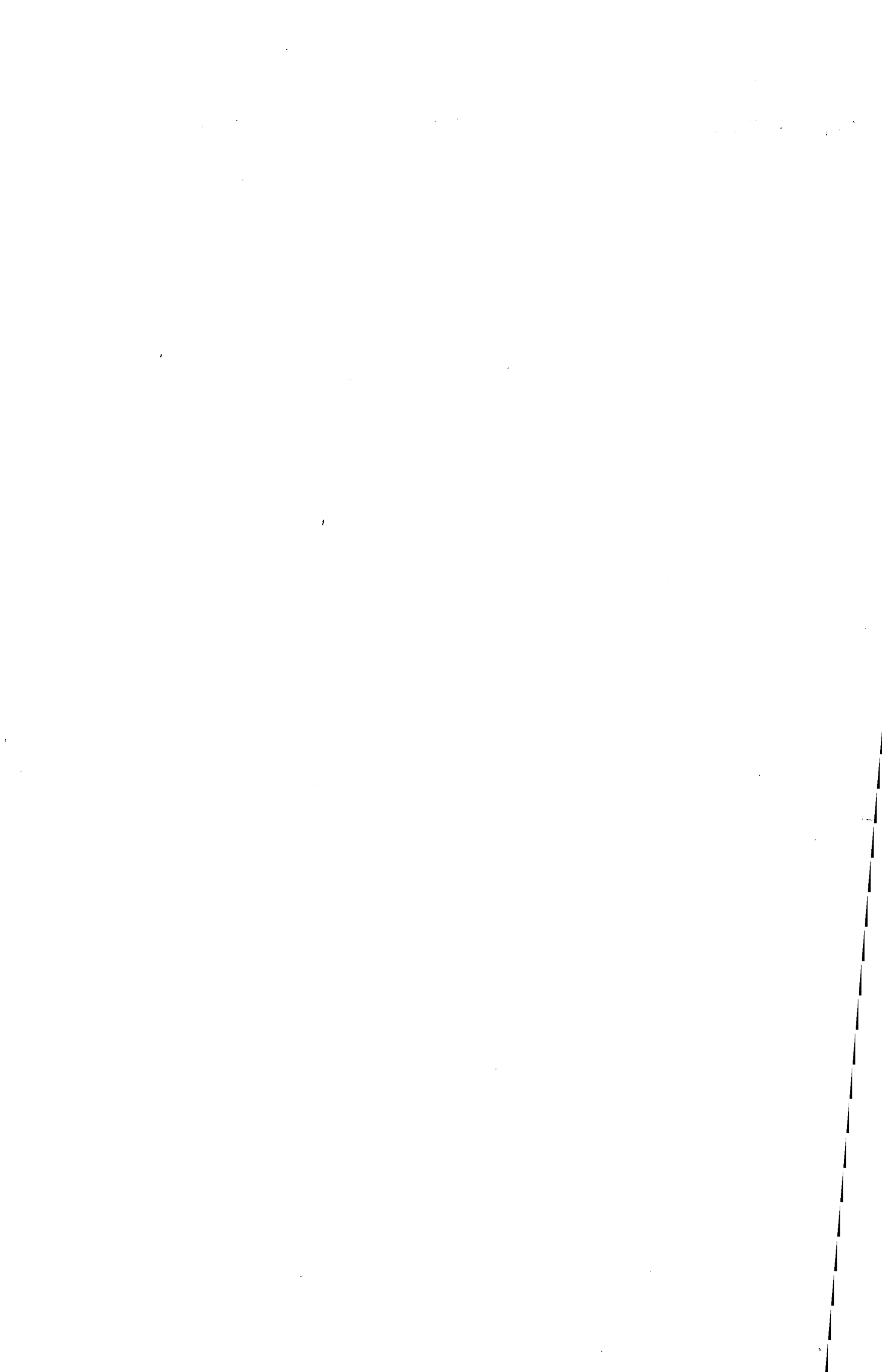

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM.

Subject : Proposal for a council Regulation amending Annex III (B) of Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 on the conversion factors applicable to albacore.

The conversion factors applicable to different species of tunny have been fixed in Annex III (B) of Regulation (EEC) No 100/76. That applicable to albacore no longer corresponds to the actual variation, in particular, between the production price of albacore and that of yellowfin tunny of 10 kg weight or less.

It is therefore proposed that the coefficient for albacore be fixed at 1,60, representing the variation of the two above-mentioned species of tunny.

FINANCIAL INCIDENCE.

There is no financial incidence.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 of 19 January 1976 on the  
common organization of the market in fishery products<sup>1</sup>, and in particular  
Article 29 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas the conversion factor of 1.25 applicable to long-finned tunny  
set out under B in Annex III to the said Regulation no longer corresponds  
to the real difference between the producer price for long-finned tunny and  
that for yellow-finned tunny weighing not more than 10 kilogrammes each;  
whereas it should therefore be changed,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

The conversion factor of "1.25" applicable to long-finned tunny and set out under B in Annex III to Regulation (EEC) No 100/76 is hereby replaced by the factor "1.60".

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
