

1. The Effects of Liberalising EFTA Trade

NOTE: The figures given below are significant because 1953-59 were the six years preceeding the formation of the European Free Trade Association. The years 1959-66 were the period during which tariffs inside EFTA were gradually abolished, and quota restrictions gradually lifted.

The tonic effect on EFTA trade is clearly illustrated by the figures. It should also be remembered that trade was also being greatly stimulated in the latter period by the parallel trade liberalisation proceeding inside the Common Market.
