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#### ED PLANATORY MEMORANDUM

By Regulations (EEC) Nos 2003/76 and 2004/76 emending Regulation (EEC)
No C17/70 laying down special provisions in respect of quality wines, the
Council adopted rules for the production of sparkling wines in the Community. The Regulations in question were applicable as from 1 September 1975,
but because of measures taken by way of derogation they will actually become
effective as from 1 September 1976. The proposed Regulation is to enable sparkling
wines produced before those two Regulations are implemented to be marketed
until they are exhausted.

## COUNCIL TEXCULATION (EEC)

emending Regulations (EEC Nos 2003/74 on sparkling wines produced in the Community and defined in item 12 of Annex II to Regulation (EEC) No 310/70 and C17/70 laying down special provisions relating to quality wines produced in specified regions

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COTTUNITIES.

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the Opinion of the European Parliament,

Heving regard to the Opinion of the Economic and Social Committee,

Whereas Council Regulations (EEC) Nos 2893/74 of 18 November 1974 on sparkling wines produced in the Community and defined in item 12 of Annex II to Regulation (EEC) N° 816/70  $^1$  and 816/70 of 28 April 1970 layind down special provisions relating to quality wines produced in specified regions  $^2$ , as last amended by Regulation (EEC) N° 1161/76  $^3$ , introduced rules with effect from 1 September 1975, for the production of sparkling wines ;

whereas Commission Regulation (DIG) No 2152/75 of 10 August 1975 on detailed rules for the application of Regulations (EEC) No 2093/74 and (DEC) No 2090/74 in respect of sparkling wines 4 laid down provisions permitting the marketing until 31 August 1976 of sparkling wines not conforming to the new rules and produced before such rules became applicable:

Whereas large stocks of these sparkling wines will not have been marketed by 31 August 1070 - whereas provision should be made for these stocks to be marketed until they are exhausted,

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#### Article 1

Article 22 of Regulation (GEC) No 2093/7% is hereby amended to read as follows :

- "1. Sparkling wines within the meaning of item 12 of Annex 17 to Regulation (CEC) No 316/70 in respect of which proof can be supplied that they were produced before 1 September 1975 and which do not conform to the provisions of Titles II, II and III of this Regulation or of Regulation (MEC) No 317/70 may be marketed provided that they conform to the previous national provisions with regard to production.
  - 2. Without projudice to other national provisions of the producer Hember State in respect of designation, they may not bear the description "quality sparkling wines".

### Article 2

Article 17 of Pogulation (FRC) No 217/70 is hereby amended to read as follows:

"Sparkling wines produced in specified regions in respect of which proof can be supplied that they were produced before 1 September 1975 but which do not conform to the previsions laid down in the fourth paragraph of Article 1 may be marketed bearing either the name of a specified region or any of the specific descriptions traditionally used which are referred to in Article 12 (2a), provided that they conform to the previous national provisions. "

#### Article 3

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

It shall apply with effect from 1 September 1976.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States,
