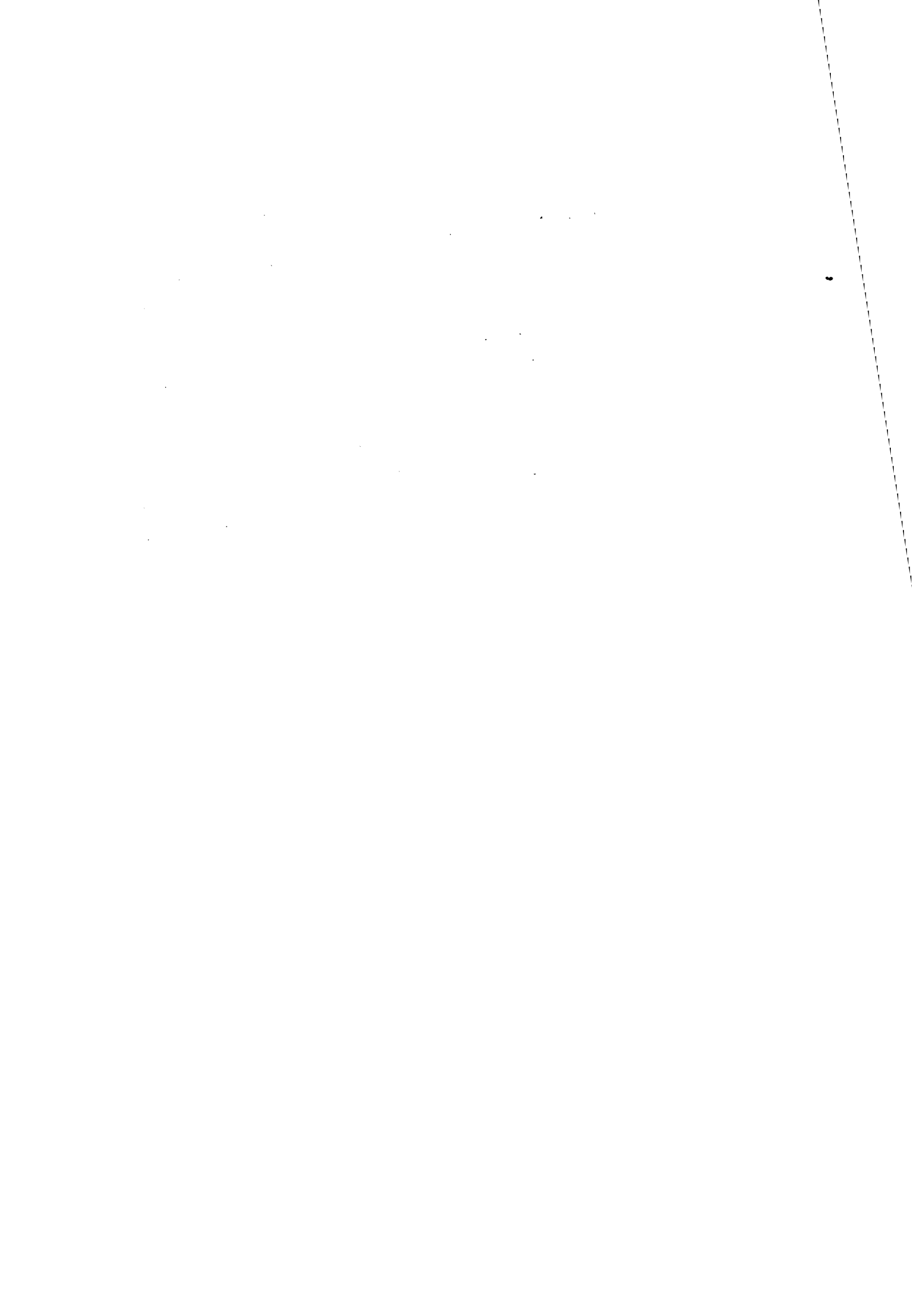

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

Subject: Proposed Council Regulation amending Regulation (EEC) No 2744/75 on the import and export system for products processed from cereals and from rice.

This proposal is intended to permit the export refunds for products processed from cereals and from rice to be fixed by tender. The reason for this refinement of the legislation is that it would facilitate control of the issue of certain export licences for processed products (eg. the long validity licences for malt), in particular those in respect of which the management of exports with a simple refund fixed once a month has proved or is expected to be too risky.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75 of 29 October 1975 on the common organization of the market in cereals <sup>(1)</sup>, as last amended by Regulation (EEC) No 1386/77 <sup>(2)</sup>, and in particular Article 16 (5) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas by Council Regulation (EEC) No 2744/75 of 29 October 1975 on the import and export system for products processed from cereals and from rice <sup>(3)</sup>, as amended by Regulation (EEC) No 832/76 <sup>(4)</sup>, the Council adopted, inter alia, general rules for granting export refunds on processed products;

Whereas those rules provided for refunds to be granted without any quantitative restriction; whereas in certain circumstances it has appeared necessary to be able to check the quantity of such products exported; whereas this requirement is met by fixing the export refund by tender,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

The following Article is hereby added to Regulation (EEC) No 2744/75:

"Article 6 a

1. The refunds may be fixed, where appropriate, by means of tenders. The tenders shall relate to the amount of the refund.
2. In that case and by way of derogation from Article 6 (6), the refunds may be fixed more than once per month.
3. The detailed rules of application for this Article shall be adopted in accordance with the procedure laid down in Article 26 of Regulation (EEC) No 2727/75."

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
