Subject : Communication from the Commission on Commission participation in the 1992 Genoa International Exhibition (SEC(90)773 final - C3-140/90)

Dear Mr Barzanti,

At its meeting of 27 November 1990, the Committee on Budgets considered the above subject.

After studying the nature of the subject and the financial implications, the Committee on Budgets has decided to deliver a favourable opinion on this proposal. It would, however, ask your committee to make certain of the validity of the costs quoted in the financial statement, as the appropriations requested by the Commission for the 1991 financial year (1.12m ECU) are lower than the initial estimate of 1.3m ECU. I would remind you that entry in the 1991 budget is subject, in the amount of 120 000 ECU, to revision of the financial perspective.
