MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr OEHLER, Mr ZAGARI, Mr LEZZI,

Mr PELIKAN and Mr RIPA di MEANA

on behalf of the Socialist Group

pursuant to Rule 25 of the Rules of Procedure

on the situation in Chile

The European Parliament,

- greatly concerned about the fate of political prisoners who have disappeared since 11 September 1973;
 - desiring a return to democracy and respect for human rights in Chile as soon as possible;
 - recalling its own resolutions on the situation in Chile;
1. Calls on the Commission, the Council and the governments of the Member States to press the Chilean authorities for an answer to the serious accusations made against them by the Human Rights Commission of the Organization of American States, Amnesty International and the Chilean Catholic Church;
 2. Urges the latter, moreover, to exert strong pressure on the Chilean military authorities to respect human rights, particularly those of exiled Chilean nationals, and to make such respect subject to no other conditions than those stipulated by the Chilean Constitution and the laws in force until 10 September 1973;
 3. Urges the Council and the governments of the Member States to suspend all economic and military aid until such time as the principles set out above are guaranteed.
 4. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Commission, Council and governments of the Member States.
