MOTION FOR A RESOLUTION

tabled by Mr LOMAS

pursuant to Rule 47 of the Rules of Procedure

on Warsaw Pact peace proposals

The European Parliament,

1. Welcomes the proposals made by the WARSAW PACT countries,
 - a. to conclude a Treaty of mutual non use of military force and preservation of peaceful relations between the WARSAW Pact and NATO states,
 - b. the drafting of a stage by stage programme of nuclear disarmament which would create conditions for the elimination of all nuclear weapons,
 - c. for a mutual commitment of the Member States not to be the first to use either nuclear or conventional weapons against each other,
 - d. for the removal of all chemical weapons from Europe, the banning of neutron weapons, the prohibiting of the deployment of weapons in outer space and the drafting of a treaty on the complete prohibition of all nuclear weapon tests;
2. Notes the urgent need to strengthen peace in Europe;
3. Notes the danger from the escalation of the arms race particularly the increase in nuclear weapons;
4. Calls on NATO Governments to respond to this initiative from the WARSAW Pact in a positive manner;
5. Instructs the President to forward this motion to all the NATO Governments.
