on the sale of arms to Uruguay by Belgium

The European Parliament,

- noting that a Member State recently concluded a contract to supply military equipment to Uruguay,
 - noting that the supply of armaments to the Uruguayan dictatorship strengthens its repressive capabilities,
1. Condemns vigorously the supply of armaments to dictatorial régimes directly or indirectly by the Member States of the Community;
 2. Instructs its President to forward this resolution to the Council and Commission.

JUSTIFICATION

The recent delivery of armaments by Belgium to Uruguay justifies the European Parliament taking a firm and rapid stand vis-à-vis the governments of the Member States.
