POLISH SITUATION

The European Parliament,

- having regard to the importance that a solution to the Polish crisis which fully respects that country's autonomy and sovereignty will have for peace and cooperation in Europe and for détente in the world at large,
 - considering that the solution of Poland's serious problems is the responsibility of the Polish people alone, without outside interference,
 - considering that all States should, in their relations with Poland, adhere to the UN Charter and the principles of the Final Act of the Helsinki Agreement and, in particular, refrain from any direct or indirect, individual or joint interference in that country's domestic affairs or external affairs falling within its national competence,
1. Considers it essential, in order to contribute to the sound development of the Polish situation, for the Community to support all efforts to further the process of détente and disarmament in Europe;
 2. Requests the Commission and Council of the European Communities to intensify short and longer-term economic and financial relations with Poland;
 3. Instructs its President to forward this motion for a resolution to the Council and Commission.
