## EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM

The purpose of this Regulation is to fix for the 1976/77 wine-growing year and pursuant to the provisions of Article 24 (6) of Regulation (EEC) N° 816/70 the purchase price of vinicdeliveries and the price of alcohol obtained from vinic deliveries under the obligation to distil the by-products of wine-making, and to determine the maximum share of the cost to be borne by the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund, Guarantee Section.

The proposal must take account of the latest amendments to Regulation (EEC) N° 816/70 and the regulation on the distillation of the by-products of wine-making. The latter regulation mainly provides for a limit on the purchase price of vinic deliveries and technical factors for determining the price of the alcohol from vinic deliveries.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community,

Having regard to Council Regulation (EEC) N° 816/70 of 28 April 1970 laying down additional provisions for the common organization of the market in wine (1), as last amended by Regulation (EEC) N° 1167/76 (2), and in particular Article 24 (6) thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Whereas under Article 24 of Regulation (EEC) N° 816/70 and Articles 2 to 4 of Council Regulation (EEC) N° /76 on the distillation of the by-products of wine-making (3) the Council fixes for each wine-growing year the purchase price of vinic deliveries and the price of the alcohol obtained from vinic deliveries under the compulsory distillation of the by-products of wine-making and determines the maximum amount of the costs of the intervention agencies to be financed by the Guarantee Section of the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund ;

Whereas, in view of the quantitative situation and the prices of table wines on the various Community markets the price paid to producers in respect of vinic deliveries should be maintained at a level near that for the 1975/76 wine-growing year .

Whereas when the price of alcohol from vinic deliveries is fixed, the criteria referred to in Article 3 (2) of Regulation (EEC) N° should be applied on a standard basis ; whereas it should be specified that this price should apply to rectified alcohol

Whereas the maximum contribution from the Guarantee Section of the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund should be fixed in the light of the situation on the market in alcohol,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION :

Article 1

1. The prices for the 1976/77 wine-growing year shall be as follows :

- 0.74 u.a. per hectolitre/degree of alcohol for the purchase of vinic deliveries,
- 0.88 ditto for alcohol from obligatory deliveries of marcs,
- 0.88 ditto for alcohol from obligatory deliveries of lees,
- 0.88 ditto for alcohol from obligatory deliveries of wine.

The price of Alcohol from vinic deliveries shall apply to rectified alcohol.

2. The maximum contribution from the Guarantee Section of the European Agricultural Guidance and Guarantee Fund for the above wine-growing year shall be 0 unit of account per hectolitre /degree of alcohol.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on 1 September 1976.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
