Subject: Extension of the EEC headquarters in
Brussels

The news that the Council of Foreign Ministers, at its meeting of 5 February 1974, had decided to enlarge the Community headquarters in Brussels caused alarm and concern among the people living in Maelbeek Valley, who have taken various steps (round table conferences, petitions, etc.) to draw attention to the serious damage and other disadvantages this project would involve.

Can the Council state to what extent it has taken account of the opposition to this project and what precisely it intends to do about the suggestions and concerns of the inhabitants of Maelbeek Valley?
