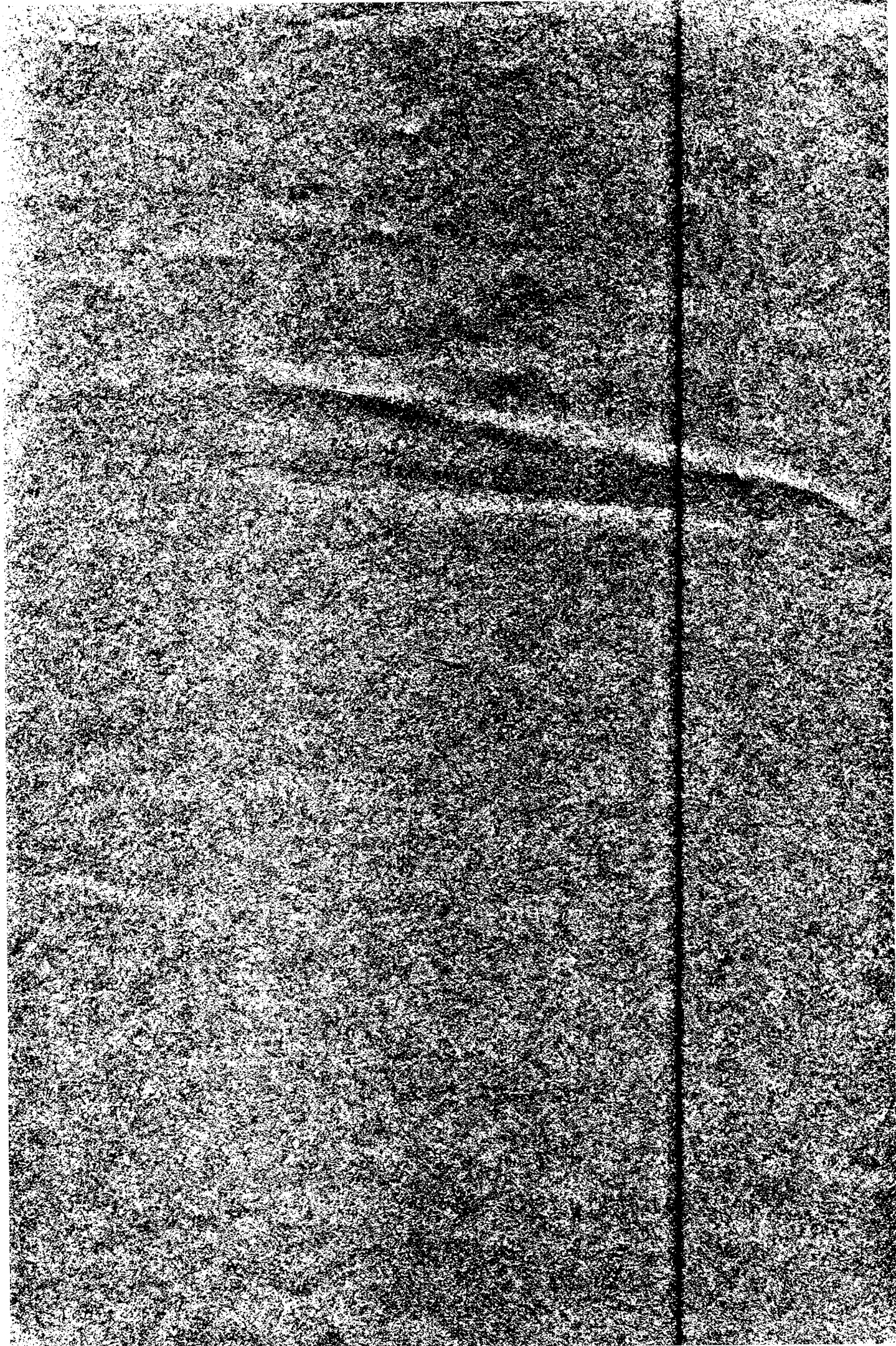

EXPLANATORY NOTE

Subject: proposal for a Council Regulation amending Regulation (EEC) No 1035/72 on the common organization of the market in fruit and vegetables.

proposal for a Council Regulation amending Regulation (EEC) No 1035/77 laying down special measures to encourage the marketing of products processed from lemons.

It was decided at the Council discussions on agricultural prices and related measures for the 1978/79 marketing year and the "Mediterranean package" to examine the possibility of making permanent the arrangements for the sale to the processing industries of blood oranges withdrawn from the market and the system of aid for the marketing of products processed from lemons.

The two attached drafts meet these objectives by deleting the references to marketing years in Article 21 of Regulation (EEC) No 1035/72 and Article 1 of Regulation (EEC) No 1035/77 respectively.

The financial effect of this proposal forms part of the overall impact of the price package and related measures which amounts, for the EAGGF Guarantee Section, to 211 m EUA for the 1978 financial year and 766 m EUA over a twelve-month period.

It should be noted that the first proposal tends to reduce expenditure in this sector.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the
European Economic Community, and in particular
Article 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the Opinion of the European Parliament,

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 1035/72 of 18 May 1972 on the common
organization of the market in fruit and vegetables⁽¹⁾, as last amended
by Regulation (EEC) No 1154/78⁽²⁾, provides that certain categories of
blood oranges withdrawn from the market may be sold to the processing industry,
during the 1977/78, 1978/79 and 1979/80 marketing years;

Whereas the situation which led to the adoption of these measures may
persist beyond the abovementioned period; whereas the said measures
should therefore be extended,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

Regulation (EEC) No 1035/72 is hereby amended as follows:

1. Under (c) of the first subparagraph of Article 21(1), the words
"during the 1977/78, 1978/79 and 1979/80 marketing years" are deleted.

2. In the second subparagraphs of Article 21 (1) and (3),
the words "until the end of the 1979/80 marketing year"
are deleted.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

THE COUNCIL OF THE EUROPEAN COMMUNITIES,

Having regard to the Treaty establishing the European Economic Community, and in particular Article 43 thereof,

Having regard to the proposal from the Commission,

Having regard to the Opinion of the European Parliament,

Whereas Council Regulation (EEC) No 1035/77 of 17 May 1977 laying down special measures to encourage the marketing of products processed from lemons⁽¹⁾ introduced a system of aid restricted to lemons harvested in the Community during the 1977/78, 1978/79 and 1979/80 marketing years;

Whereas the effects of the restructuring measures undertaken by the producer Member States in the lemon sector will not be felt in the immediate future; whereas, consequently, this system of aid should be extended beyond the date initially laid down,

HAS ADOPTED THIS REGULATION:

Article 1

In Article 1 (1) of Regulation (EEC) No 1035/77, the words " for the 1977/78, 1978/79 and 1979/80 marketing years" are hereby deleted.

Article 2

This Regulation shall enter into force on the third day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Communities.

This Regulation shall be binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
